Re: Humanitarian Aid for Victims of Earthquake and Tsunami in Central Sulawesi

Referring to our previous press release dated 2 October 2018, the Indonesian Embassy in Berlin expresses its gratitude and appreciation to the People, Government, and NGO's in the Federal Republic of Germany in helping the victims of the earthquake and tsunami in Central Sulawesi.

Germany's Humanitarian Aid arrived in the form of generators from the Bundesanstalt Technisches Hilfswerk and water purification system from the International Search and Rescue (ISAR) Germany. Furthermore, a significant amount of donation has been sent to various local organizations in Indonesia to mitigate the hardship situation.

The Indonesian Embassy in Berlin still receives numerous inquiries from people as well as organizations in Germany offering their help for the victims. In this connection, the Embassy would like to inform the following matter:

- Humanitarian partners should make concrete, written offers to the Indonesian representatives, which will review the said matter to ensure the offer meets its needs, before granting access. Humanitarian partners are encouraged to fill out the following link <http://bit.ly/SASOP4Sulawesi> before mobilizing any logistics or teams. After approval, flight clearance and administrative arrangements must be coordinated with the German Embassy in Jakarta.
- Permission will be given to foreign humanitarian workers serving as operators/technicians of specific equipment from outside of the country, e.g. water treatment facilities, for a certain period of time. International humanitarian partners are encouraged to team up with local NGO's in Indonesia.
