

## LIMITED STAY VISA (VISA TINGGAL TERBATAS / VITAS)

**Limited Stay Visa** is a single entry visa issued for a visit that is related to work and to other purposes such as investment, research, family unification, performance, sport, social activities, retired/senior citizen, etc.

The holder of the Limited Stay Visa is able to extend the visa and to obtain the temporary permit (KIMS/KITAS) once he/she arrives in Indonesia. The single/multiple exit and re-entry permit are able to obtain from the Directorate General of Immigration if the holder of the Limited Stay Visa is planning to exit and re-enter Indonesia within the period of valid stay permit.

## VISUM MET EEN BEPERKTE VERBLIJF (VISA Tinggal Terbatas / VITAS)

Een Visum met een beperkte Verblijf is een enkele inreis visum dat wordt afgegeven voor een bezoek dat is gerelateerd aan het werk en voor andere doeleinden zoals investeringen, onderzoek, gezinshereniging, optredens, sport, sociale activiteiten, gepensioneerden/senioren burgers, enz.

De houder van een Limited Stay Visa wordt in staat gesteld om het visum om te zetten tot een tijdelijke verblijfsvergunning (KIMS / KITAS) als hij / zij aankomt in Indonesië. De houder van een Limited Stay Visa kan bij het directoraat-generaal van Immigratie een single/multiple exit en re-entry permit toestemming aanvragen indien hij/zij van plan is Indonesia uit te gaan en wederom Indonesia binnen komt, binnen de gestelde geldige verblijfsperiode.

## **Requirements:**

1. A passport which has at least one blank page for visa (amendment and endorsement pages cannot be used for visa), with at least:
  - a. 12 months validity for 6 months stay;
  - b. 18 months validity for 12 months stay; or
  - c. 30 months validity for 24 months stay
2. Two recent color photographs (passport size) with white background on picture-quality paper.  
Note: Do not staple or affixed the photographs on the form.
3. Completed and signed application form (in duplicate).
4. Limited Stay Visa Authorization Letter from the Indonesian Directorate General of Immigration.  
Note:  
An application will not be processed without a formal notification of authorization from the Indonesian Directorate General of Immigration. To initiate and expedite the process of the Authorization, it is advisable that the applicant's sponsor in Indonesia submit a request for authorization to the Directorate General of Immigration in Jakarta, Indonesia. Please make sure that the notification is addressed to the Indonesian Embassy/Consulate Generals in which the visa will be issued.
5. Applicants under 18 years of age should attach a notarized copy of birth certificate. In addition, a notarized letter of consent signed by non-traveling legal guardian must be attached if the applicant under 18 years of age travels without the legal guardian.
6. Inoculation is recommended but not mandatory, and is required only if applicant had previously traveled to areas/ countries infected by yellow fever.
7. Payment in money order, company's check or cashier's check.
