

# VISIT VISA

Visit Visa is issued for foreigner who will travel to Indonesia using a regular passport for government duties purpose, education, social, cultural, business, family, journalism or layover to continue the journey to another country.

For short visit of maximum 30 days, citizens of 169 countries, special administrative regions (SAR) and entities including Suriname and Guyana do not need visa to travel to Indonesia.

Citizen from countries that are allowed to use Visa on Arrival (VoA) and planning to visit Indonesia for more than 30 days up to a maximum 60 days is suggested to choose VoA rather than Visit Visa.

# EEN BEZOEK VISUM

Een Bezoek Visum wordt gegeven aan buitenlanders die naar Indonesië wensen af te reizen met een burgerpaspoort bijvoorbeeld voor overheidsdiensten, onderwijs, sociale, culturele, toerisme, zakelijke, familie, journalistieke doeleinden, of tussenstop om hun reis voort te zetten naar een ander land.

Burgers met specifieke toeristische doeleinden van 169 landen, waaronder Suriname en Guyana, hebben geen visum nodig om af te reizen naar Indonesia.

Echter, worden burgers van landen die in aanmerking zijn gekomen voor het aanvragen van Visum bij Aankomst (VoA) en die van plan zijn minder dan 30 dagen te verblijven sterk aanbevolen om te kiezen voor VoA in plaats voor het aanvraag van een Bezoek Visum.

## General requirements for Visit Visa

The fee for Single entry is **US \$50.00**; for multiple entries is **US\$ 110.00**

1. Copy of legal passport which valid at least 6 months at the date of entry in Indonesia; or valid at least 1 year at the date of entry for the Multiple Entries. Passport contains at least one blank visa page. Amendment and endorsement pages cannot be used for visa purposes.
2. Application form (in duplicate) must be completed and signed by the applicant.

3. Two recent color photographs (passport size or as much as 4 cm x 6 cm) on picture-quality paper with white background.
4. Copy of return ticket to Indonesia or season ticket to continue travel to another country
5. Original sponsor letter or invitation letter from Indonesia. Please include copy of Identification/ID card of the person who signed the letter.
6. For visitor who is not covered during staying in Indonesia, should provide copy of proof of living expenses for himself/herself and family (e.g: Copy of bank statement indicates the current applicant's fund or indicates the applicant has a sufficient fund, at least two weeks prior to the date of applying visa).

**NOTE: please bring all the original documents when submitting the requirements.**

## Procedure to apply Regular Visit Visa

1. Applicant submit all the requirements, the staff of the embassy will verifies all the copies with the original document. **Note: the embassy will not process uncompleted application.**
2. Applicant receives receipt from the embassy that the application has been submitted.  
**Note: receiving the application DOES NOT mean that the visa has been approved. IF NECESSARY, please provide time for short interview in verifying the requirements.**
3. The Embassy will inform the applicant when the application is approved.  
**Note: Please be advised that all Indonesian Representative (Embassies or Consulate Generals) hold the right to deny any applicant that deemed ineligible without disclosing the reason.**
4. If the application has been approved, the application may pay the fee for the visa and bring the original passport to the embassy.  
**Note: please allow 2-3 working days to process the visa into the passport after the application has been approved.**
