

FREE VISA FOR SHORT VISIT

The Government of Indonesia is pleased to announce as of April 1, 2016 that the following citizens are exempted from obtaining visa for short visit to Indonesia for **the following purpose:**

1. Tourism
2. Family
3. Social
4. Art and Cultural
5. Official visit
6. Giving Lecture or attending seminar
7. Attending a meeting held by head office or Representative office in Indonesia
8. Attending International Exhibition

Please confirm your eligibility by sending an email to konsuler.wellington@kemlu.go.id in regards to the purpose of your visit for point 3 to 7.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Free Visa for Short Visit is given to travelers visiting Indonesia **for the purpose mentioned above for a maximum stay of 30 days** and **cannot be extended or converted** to any other types of Stay Permit
2. Free Visa for Short Visit entry stamp can only be **obtained at certain points of arrival in Indonesia (see the list below)**
3. ***If you are planning to stay longer than 30 days, you will need to apply for a Visit Visa prior to arrival in Indonesia***
4. ***Indonesia does not accept Travel Documents or Temporary passports as a proof of your country citizenship/nationality***

Due to the high level of security with Airline Carrier, it is advisable to check with the airline company whether you can board without an Indonesian visa in your passport.

Visa Requirements:

1. Passport validity must be valid for more than 6 months from date of entry to Indonesia.
2. Return airline ticket / Ongoing ticket
